Lake Forest Pool Rules and Regulations

The following rules have been adopted to regulate the use of our community pool and to help foster safety for all who use the facility:

Use of the Lake Forest pool is restricted to homeowners and their guests.

Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

Resident youth under the age of 21 may not congregate at the pool after dark unless accompanied by an adult homeowner.

Infants using the pool must be outfitted with "swim diapers." Should any fecal matter be found in the pool, it must be reported to the Community Manager at once, and the pool closed pending cleaning and treatment.

Glass bottles or other breakable containers are not allowed in the pool area. All drinks must be in plastic bottles or aluminum cans

No running or diving into the pool is allowed. Water sports may be conducted but shall not interfere with other's use of the pool.

No loud music may be played.

Pool parties are permitted on a non-exclusive use basis but must first be coordinated with the Community Manager.

1. Adult homeowners must supervise any party involving minors.
2. No glass or ceramic plates or other breakable materials may be brought into the pool area.
3. The organizer of the party will be responsible for cleanup. Should the pool area used for the party not be left in a broom-clean condition, the party organizer will be assessed a \$250 cleaning fee by the Association.
4. Bookings are on a first come, first served basis. The Community Manager will post a calendar of scheduled pool events on the pool bulletin board.
5. An event must be booked through the Community Manager at least by the nearest weekday (Mon-Fri) prior to the event. (Examples: An event on a Saturday must be booked at least by Friday. An event on a Monday also must be booked by the previous Friday.)
6. Any private gathering of 10 or more attendees must be approved as stated above.
7. The pool may be booked for a maximum of 50 people during any one time period, regardless of the number of concurrent groups. It may be booked for more than one event at the same time, at the discretion of the Community Manager.
